


School Counsellors

- Provides individual and group counselling to students
- Provide consultation as well as planning and conducting training for staff and parents on social, emotional and behavioural issues.




Student Welfare Officer (SWO)

- Provides social support to students who may have challenges attending school regularly
- Works with families and other community partners to address barriers to learning and strengthen the safety net




ECG Counsellor

- Education and Career Guidance (ECG) Counsellor helps students to explore their strengths, interests and aspirations
- Guides students in making informed plans and decisions for education and career



SEN Officers

- Provides support to students with special educational needs (SEN)
- Support students with intervention support



Special Educational Needs (SEN)

- Parents are strongly encouraged to share information on your child's/ward's Special Educational Needs (SEN) so that the school can better understand the support needed.
- The support provided in a secondary school will <u>vary</u> from the support received in a primary school.
- We aim to work with the students to achieve independence in an inclusive environment.




Access Arrangements for School-Based Assessment

- Access Arrangements (AA) are special provisions made to minimise barriers faced by students with diagnosed conditions (e.g. SEN – special educational needs) under exam settings.
- If your child/ward has been granted AA at primary school level/PSLE, you will still need to re-apply for AA at secondary school.
- Parents/Guardians who wish to apply for AA for their child/ward for school-based examinations will need to complete <u>AA Form 1</u> and return this by 22 January 2024 (Monday).
- If you have already received a copy of <u>AA Form 1</u>, no further action is required.






Timetable Structure
